Move Ups: Move-ups/lateral moves are allowed Trial to Trial. Move ups must be given to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes before the start of the next trial.

Rings: Rings are indoors on dirt. This is a 2 ring event with a maximum ring size of 24 X 24 feet.

Blinds: The 10 x 15 blinds are located indoors and will be limited to 5 dogs Instinct, Novice, Open, Senior & Crazy 8's. Master is limited to four dogs.

Entry Limits: Judge is limited to 8 hours of judging and a maximum run value, which will require this club to limit entries accordingly.

Entries: Entries are accepted by mail or online through **Dogshow.com** on or after the entry opening date as noted in the trial entry form. **Entries for the first week will be accepted 50% from mail and 50% from online.** Entries are not accepted via text, or other messaging platforms. Entries must be complete with payment and have valid physical or digital signatures. Entries received between the opening date and closing date pay the pre-entry fee rate.

Route 66 Barn Hunt of Oklahoma (the Club) reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Club or any official thereof. Dogs may not be brought to the gate in any disallowed collar or on a Flexi-lead. Dogs **MUST** run "naked," without a collar/harness. Dogs should be brought to the ring with collars/harnesses which can be easily and quickly removed and replaced.

Bitches in season may enter this trial but are required to be kept separate from all other dogs and will be run at the end of their class/trial. They must wear pants/britches at all times including on the course. Entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded until closing time of the trial if you wish to withdraw. If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the trial committee prior to the trial, and you must inform all exhibitors at the Judge's briefing.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each is solely responsible for having the dog ready when his/her class is to be judged.

It is expressly understood that participants are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s). Participants whose dogs create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the event site. In such a case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Club will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by participants or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property.

It is your responsibility to read and be familiar with BHA rules, which includes but not limited to facility grounds, collars and leashes allowed, cell phone/smartwatch policy. It can be found at www.barnhunt.com.

A final confirmation of further scheduling details will be emailed to all exhibitors before the trial. If you do not receive an email, please contact the trial secretary. Dogs being handled by the same person will be separated into different staged groups. Dogs may be measured at the discretion of the Judge.

CRATING – Indoor crating allowed. Crating area is on dirt.

New title ribbons will be given.

Height Divisions:

Small: Dogs 15" & under

Medium: Dogs 15.1" to 22"

Large: Dogs over 22"

Refunds will be refunded

- If the entry is withdrawn prior to the closing date.
- If the competitor who entered the trial must withdraw due to COVID-19 confirmed by a doctor.
- If the event must be canceled by BHA, State, or local authorities.
- If the entry is withdrawn after the closing date, and there is someone on the waitlist to take the withdrawn spot.

Entry Fees Not Refunded

- If the entry is withdrawn after the closing date and does not qualify for a refund exception.
- In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.
- If the trials cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the Event Committee.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Building is enclosed.
- Bring your own water and bowls for your dogs.
- Possessing or training with personal, live quarry is not permitted on the show grounds at any time.
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring.
- Leashes cannot be left dangling or dragging.
- Exhibitors are responsible to clean up after their dogs.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being ready to go to the staging area, in the staging area, and waiting for the call to the gate when it is their turn to run. The Judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class.
- The Club assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs, property, or children.

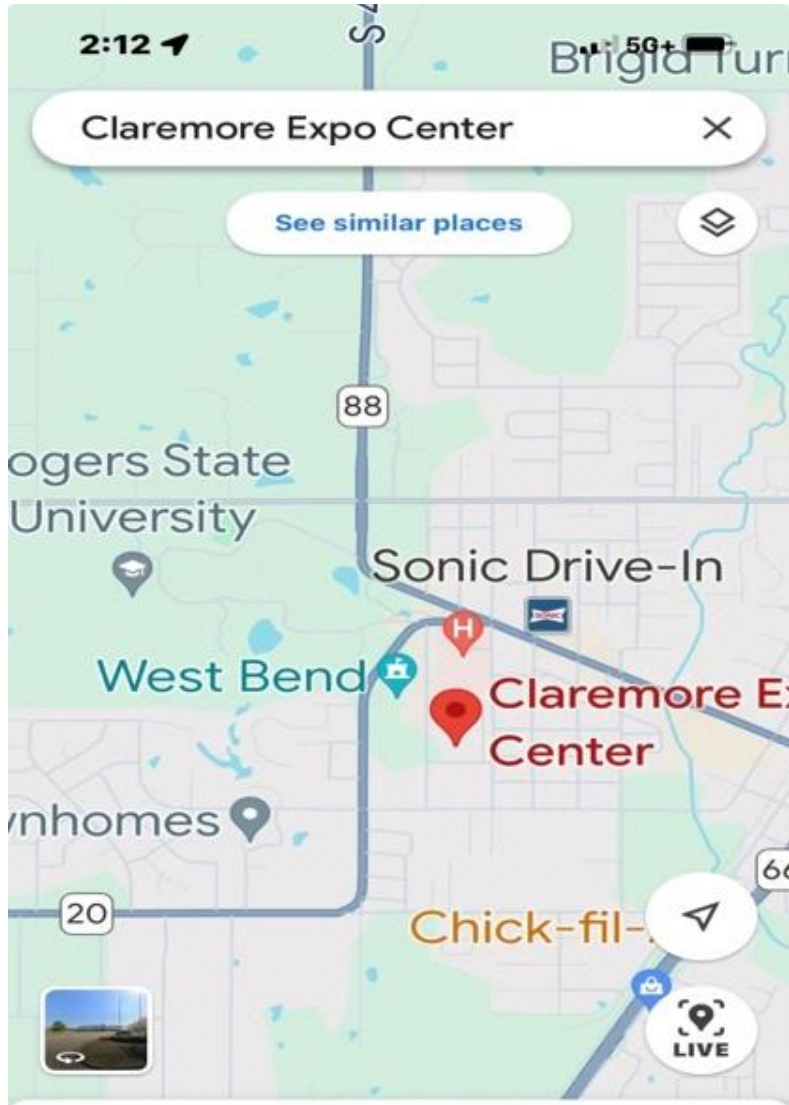

I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard (dog or human aggressive) to persons or other dogs. This entry is submitted for acceptance on the foregoing representation and Agreement. I (we) agree to conduct myself (ourselves) in accordance with all Barn Hunt Association, LLC Rules and Regulations and to abide by any decisions made in accord with them.

LIABILITY WAIVER
