ENTRIES CLOSE: Wednesday, May 20, 2026, 11:00 am (CDT) or until maximum entry limits per day are met, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

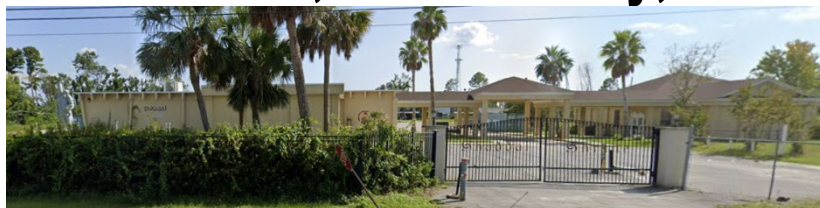

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR, and LIABILITY: The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and can perform all searches **safely**. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the **behavior** of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive **behavior** may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Greater **PANAMA CITY DOG FANCIERS'** Association and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no **liability** for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Greater **PANAMA CITY DOG FANCIERS'** Association reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against Greater **PANAMA CITY DOG FANCIERS'** Association or any official thereof.

COLLARS, LEASHES, HARNESES: During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the Judge. A wearable camera (such as a Go Pro) may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, and **RETRACTABLE LEASHES MAY NOT BE USED WHEN ON TRIAL GROUNDS** (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the Judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

REFUNDS: No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical conditions are not eligible for a refund.

Bitches in Season will be refunded the full entry fee minus the AKC recording fee. Notification in writing must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

A \$5 administrative fee will be charged for ALL withdrawals before closing.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. Greater **PANAMA CITY DOG FANCIERS'** Association has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Exhibitors MUST check-in EACH day they are entered AND AT EACH GATE for each element.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Condition of the Dog: Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the Judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are NOT eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind can participate so long as the handler is always in control of the dog, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the Judge. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free from internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

SEARCH AREA AND CONDITIONS

Search areas may be of any shape and of the size specified in the "Regulations for AKC Scent Work" for each class. Search area conditions may be indoors on matted, carpeted, or tiled surfaces; or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces.

Search area sizes will be as required in the "Regulations for AKC Scent Work."

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Trial Site: It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments, and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

Possession of Odors and Training: Chapter 5, Section 35 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area."

Spectator Area: Spectators are encouraged. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run except in the case of Handler Discrimination classes. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide(s).

STAGING AREA, HANDLERS' BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Staging Area: Check-in, Results, and Ribbons will be on a table inside of the building adjacent to the parking lot. The Secretary will be inside of that building. The warm-up area will be in the grassy area outside of the shady and covered pavilion where you can set up your crates and chairs. The public restrooms are also in this shady and covered pavilion.

Handlers' Briefing: The first briefing is at 8:00 am with the first Novice dog to follow. Each briefing will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handlers' Briefing, the judge will explain if there is an off-leash option, the number of hides, the maximum height of hides, and the maximum time for the search. No dogs are to be present during the Handlers' Briefing.

Warm-up Area: As stated above, the warm-up area will be in the grassy area outside of the shady and covered pavilion. One labeled container per target odor will be placed in the warm-up area. This will allow handler-dog teams to prepare for the search prior to their run. Each team WILL limit their warm-up to 2 minutes or less so that others may be able to use the warm-up area as well. The warm-up area is NOT for training or relieving the dog (Chapter 5, Section 34 of the Scent Work Regulations).

Potty Area: Please follow the signs for the designated Potty Area. Your dog must remain on leash (**NOT retractable**) at all times. No parking allowed on grass areas as all vehicles will be parked inside the designated, gated, parking lot. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without the benefit of a refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available in the Potty Area.

Food: No food will be available on site. There are numerous restaurants on Hwy-98 or on 23rd Street, a few minutes from the trial building.

HANDLER DISCRIMINATION DIVISION

Handler Discrimination classes are titling classes in which the targeted scent is that of the handler themselves. Handlers are required to provide their own scented articles in a plastic bag. For the Novice class, one cotton glove or cotton sock, for Advanced, Excellent, and Master, cotton balls or cotton swabs. Three qualifying scores are required to earn titles in each class.

RIBBONS

Placement ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

First Place	Blue Flat
Second Place	Red Flat
Third Place	Yellow Flat
Fourth Place	White Flat
Qualifying Score	Dark Green Flat

A New Title Flat may be awarded to dogs finishing a title

HIGH IN TRIAL

Only teams who participate in the same difficulty level in all elements offered and qualify in each are eligible to win High In Trial (HIT). One HIT winner is chosen per level (there is no separate HIT for Novice A and B). The HIT is determined by adding the team's fault across the elements. If there is a tie based on faults, then the team's times across the elements will be summed and the faster finishing team will win. The HIT award is not recorded by the AKC. Teams winning HIT will earn a rosette.

HIGH COMBINED DIVISION

If a club chooses to offer the HIT award and is also offering Handler Discrimination classes, then they must also confer the High Combined Division (HCD) awards. Only teams who participate in the same difficulty level in all elements offered plus Handler Discrimination and qualify in each are eligible to win (HCD). One HCD winner is chosen per level (there is no separate HCD for Novice A and B). The HCD is determined by adding the team's fault across the elements. If there is a tie based on faults, then the team's times across the elements will be summed and the faster finishing team will win. The HCD award is not recorded by the AKC. Teams winning HCD will earn a rosette.

No entries will be accepted by phone, email, fax, or hand delivery. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at Emerald Coast Dog Shows' address. No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted, which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

No fee is charged to enter the wait list once the trial is full. If a spot becomes available prior to the trial closing, the club will notify exhibitors in a priority order of date entered and be offered a spot in the trial. Any waitlisted entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will not be charged. We will maintain a wait list of 50 entries per trial.
